- **Portfolio Support:** Assist in the day-to-day management of existing portfolios and grants. This involves writing reports, preparing background documents, and completing administrative tasks to ensure compliance with funding requirements.
- Training and Support: Offer support to staff in utilising internal tools and guidelines to enhance fundraising skills and effectiveness. Provide guidance on best practices for fundraising activities
